BACKGROUND

The South Carolina Society of Professional Land Surveyors established the South Carolina Society of Professional Land Surveyors SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND on May 9, 1998.

PURPOSE

To financially assist in the education of those deserving students who are pursuing a career in the Profession of Land Surveying.

SPONSORSHIP

The South Carolina Society of Professional Land Surveyors Scholarship Trust Fund is sponsored by the South Carolina Society of Professional Land Surveyors and is administered by a board of trustees comprised of the current President of the SCSPLS, and six other full SCSPLS members.

FUNDING

Initial funding of the scholarship trust was by private charitable contributions and contributions from the SCSPLS assets. Interest bearing accounts will fund the scholarships. Addition contributions are added to the fund principal.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The recipient must be a resident of the State of South Carolina and pursuing a career goal in Land Surveying at an accredited college acceptable to the scholarship trustees. Preference will be given to those students in full time bachelors program; however, full consideration will be given to associate degree program students and part time students on a prorated scholarship basis. The recipient must have completed 20% of the degree requirements before any scholarship monies are awarded. A student is only eligible once per fiscal year.

REQUIREMENTS OF RECIPIENT

The recipient must maintain a course load averaging 12 or more credit hours if regarded as a full-time student. Part-time students must maintain a course load averaging 6 credit hours or more. Recipient must maintain a 2.5 overall grade point average and a 2.75 grade point average in surveying courses.

AWARDS

The amount of award shall be determined by the SCSPLS Scholarship Committee. Award for fulltime students shall not exceed \$1,500.00. Award for part-time students shall not exceed \$750.00.
